Objectives:

Students reflect on their new understandings of global water

• Students compare their reflections with their original understandings

Background Information:

This lesson replicates the first lesson in Global Water Awareness and Active Citizenship in order for students to discover their deepened understanding in global water issues.

Materials:

- Laptop, sound dock, projector, flip chart paper
- Powerpoint presentation: "Water is Unfit for Human Consumption" (see resource section below for link to slideshow)
- Graphic Organizer/Handout (double sided) 'My Thinking' and 'Images in my Mind'

Teaching/Learning Sequence:

VIEW PRESENTATION: Project PowerPoint presentation: "Water is Unfit for Human Consumption". (see resource section below for link to presentation)

The overall format and strategy for this lesson is THINK-PAIR-SHARE

HANDOUT: Student page/graphic organizer: 'My thinking' and 'Images in my Mind'

Question: What connections did you make and thoughts did you have while reviewing the presentation?

ACTIVITY: After reviewing the power point, students individually complete the Student page. Reminder about THINK time and the room is quiet. Students then compare with their original organizer.

ACTIVITY: A-B PARTNERS to think, pair, share. General discussion. Students get into A-B partners and share what they recorded upon review and how that compares with their original Thinking. Compare original graphic organizer with organizer complete during review/reflection. What is the new learning? How are organizers the same? How are they different?

Closure/Reflection Discussion:

DEBRIEF/BRAINSTORM/DISCUSS: Pairs share with large group the three important points they made in their discussion. Teacher to FLIP CHART ideas as they are being shared.
